- b) Discuss Chaucer’s portrayal of ecclesiastical order in the *General Prologue*.
- c) Critically discuss how Donne unites the body and the mind in his poem “The Extasie”.
- d) Do you consider Donne’s poem “The Canonization” as a metaphysical poem? Discuss.
- e) Comment on Pope’s presentation of Atticus in “An Epistle to Dr. Arbuthnot”.
